

# OAKLAWN CEMETERY RULES & REGULATIONS

## PLEASE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING RULES

1. All planting of shrubs or trees must first be cleared with the cemetery.
2. No curbing, fencing, brick pavers or wood ties around graves are allowed.
3. Crushed stone or wood chips are not permitted around memorials, trees, or shrubs.
4. No planting full length of graves or lots are permitted.
5. No rose bushes permitted.
6. Any plantings, shrubs or trees wrongfully placed will be removed by the cemetery without notice.
7. Unsightly flower containers or decorations will be removed by the cemetery without notice.
8. Potted flowers not in permanent urns or cut flowers in vases can only be placed on the grave during the period of two weeks before and after Memorial Day.
9. Winter grave blankets and wreath are permitted November 15<sup>th</sup> to March 1<sup>st</sup>
10. Artificial flowers and live planting must be as follows:
  - a. Urns are to be placed only within 12" of the front or ends of the monument
  - b. For planting, remove 12" strip of sod only in front of the monument.
  - c. No glass containers.
  - d. The above will be removed at the end of the season. (Approximately October 15<sup>th</sup> thru April 1<sup>st</sup>.)
